BWR was founded in 2015 by members of the local community with a desire to welcome refugees and became a registered charity in 2017.

Their mission is to help refugees rebuild their lives with dignity, security, and opportunities to thrive within local communities. BWR activities include the delivery of integrated social support; help and protection for physical, mental, and financial hardship; resettlement and befriending; fundraising; tuition, particularly in relation to English language support; the finding, furnishing, and renovation of homes and gardens; the protection of data and every aspect of safeguarding; and the enhancement of the lives of those they support. They have over 200 volunteers supporting children and adults, refugees and asylum seekers from Syria, Afghanistan, Ukraine, and other countries, and since 2015 they have supported over 800 people.

They are now seeking a new Head of Charity who will provide strategic leadership, operational oversight, and external representation for Bath Welcomes Refugees. You will work closely with the Board of Trustees, Management Committee, staff, and volunteers to develop and implement the charity's strategy, secure funding, and ensure high-quality support for refugees and asylum seekers. The Head of Charity will be responsible for financial and risk management, stakeholder engagement, and ensuring compliance with legal and regulatory requirements.
